*(English Standard Version)*

**People: ... and [He] shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.**

Leader: In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely.

**People: And this is the name by which he will be called: ‘The LORD is our righteousness.’**

Leader: “Therefore, behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when they shall no longer say, ‘As the LORD lives who brought up the people of Israel out of the land of Egypt,’

**People: but ‘As the LORD lives who brought up and led the offspring of the house of Israel ...**

**People: Then they shall dwell in their own land.”**
