Title: "A Refresher on God's View of Pre-Born Human Life"

Text: Exodus 21:22-25

Theme: The destruction of innocent human life will be avenged by Almighty God. All who confess and forsake this sin, whether held as a belief or committed in actual deed, will find total and complete forgiveness and be redeemed from the spiritual penalty through Christ, who bore the curse of this violation.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What is the situation that the text employs to highlight the principle to be taught (v. 22a)?
2. What third person is brought into this situation, whether by accident or intentionally (v. 22a)?
3. What is the specific, unhappy consequence that occurs from this situation (v. 22b)?
4. If the woman's child or children are prematurely born, but there is no injury sustained (to either the mother or the child), what is to be done (v. 22c)?
5. Who determines the amount of the penalty (v. 22d, e)?
6. What happens if there is an injury sustained to the mother or to the prematurely born child(ren) (vv. 23-25)?
7. What would happen to the person responsible for causing the premature birth of the pregnant woman's child, or children, if a death occurred to the mother or the child (v. 23b)?
8. What is the principle of punishment that is set forth in this law (vv. 23-25)?
9. Who is covered by the "injury" condition, the mother, the child, or both?
10. What erroneous interpretation has been suggested by the premature birth of the pregnant mother's child, or children?
11. How does this erroneous interpretation interpret the extent of the penalty?
12. How does this erroneous interpretation view the unborn child?
13. Why is this interpretation wrong?
14. Do you think that messages about abortion still need to be delivered today in the Church? Why or why not?
15. What is the rationale that many people use to justify taking the life of an unborn child?
16. What might be effective in changing the hearts of people who view the unborn child as a non-person?
17. What has been quite effective in changing the minds and opinions of those who were intent on having an abortion?
18. Can someone be guilty of the sin of abortion by merely advocating for it? Are apologists for abortion, whether male or female, guilty of this sin? If so, to what extent?
19. Is the sin of abortion forgivable?
20. How may someone guilty of abortion be forgiven?
21. How can someone who is guilty of having an abortion or who strongly advocated for abortion, upon receiving forgiveness from God, also forgive himself or herself?
22. How can the Church tangibly love and support those who seek forgiveness and restoration from this sin?

THE LORD'S SUPPER

Announcement:

All are invited to the Lord's Table who have been baptized, have publicly professed (either before a congregation of the Lord's Church or to a body of Elders in a church where the Gospel of Christ is embraced) faith in and allegiance to the Lord Jesus Christ as the Savior from your sins, and are members of the visible Church of the Lord Jesus Christ.

If you have not publicly professed faith in Christ Jesus – the eternal Son of God who took on human flesh, lived a perfect, sinless life, died on the cross for sins, rose bodily from the dead, and who is returning to this earth in power and glory – please refrain from partaking of the Lord's Table.

We invite you to respond to the Gospel by first understanding that you have sinned personally against the God who made you and have violated His good and right laws for you to follow. God is holy and has every right to separate you from Himself and from all that is good and beautiful because of your freely chosen disobedience to Him. But the really good news is that you can be restored to the God who made you because of what Christ Jesus has done on the cross as a perfect substitute and payment for the penalty that you owe and deserve. Simply believing and trusting in what Jesus did for you means you will belong to the LORD God forever.

Abraham, the Biblical example of one who was restored to God by faith alone, trusted God's promise and the LORD God credited it, that trust, to him as righteousness. God has shown His love to the world, and to you, by giving His only Son that whoever believes in Him should not die and be separated from Him forever but rather have the life man was created to have in the presence of God, a life that never ends.

This means that you cannot DO anything to earn your place with God. However, a true faith in Christ Jesus comes from a God-given desire that will produce behavior that does those things that are pleasing to Him.

Please seek out and contact one of our Pastors or Elders to talk more about your eternal future. You can find their contact information in this bulletin. They will be glad to show you from Scripture, God's Word, how you can have a relationship with God through Christ Jesus and have true peace and security with Him.

If you have professed faith in Christ Jesus, have been baptized, and are a member of the Church, yet there is a distance between you and the LORD because of cherished and unrepentant sin and transgressions of God's laws, we warn you to refrain from partaking the elements of the Lord's Table today. Scripture tells us that partaking of the Lord's Table is a participation, a communion, in the body and blood of Christ (1 Cor. 10:16). God's people cannot partake of His holy Table while at the same time engaging in deliberate and conscious violations of His commands for us as His holy people. If this is true with you, the LORD graciously promises that, if you confess and turn from whatever thinking or behavior that is contrary to His nature and His Word, He is faithful to forgive and to cleanse you from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). Until you have confessed and turned from whatever this breach of faith might be, please refrain from partaking of the Lord's Table.

This does not mean that as a professing follower of Christ you are required to be perfect and flawless before communing with Christ at His Table. The Table is for you to be nourished and strengthened even more in your faith and love for Christ. You may have worries and doubts that God loves or hears you because your faith is weak. You may have sinned, confessed, and turned from it to the Lord before partaking, but still your heart condemns you. When you come to the Lord's Table, the Lord by faith assures you that you belong to Him, and He belongs to you. If, despite your sins and imperfections, you can truly say that the LORD is your Shepherd, that the name of Christ and His smile is the desire of your soul, then take the LORD at His word that you are ransomed, healed, restored, forgiven!

Come, and dine with your Lord and Savior.

CONFESSION OF SIN
