9.	What kinds of songs are God's people to sing (v. 19a)?
10.	How are Christians to address one another and sing to the Lord (v. 19b)?
11.	For what things are followers of Jesus to give thanks (v. 20a)?
12	When are Christians to be thankful and express it (v. 20a)?

13.	Why should Christians be people who submit (v. 21b)?
