- 5. What was Hosea's response to how Israel's past sin had affected her? (v. 14)?
- 6. Where was the place that Israel's present sins against the LORD were very pronounced and aggravated (v. 15a)?
- 7. Because of their wickedness, what would the LORD God do (v. 15b)?
- 8. How does the LORD describe Israel's leaders (v. 15c)?
- 9. What two things in particular were to happen to Ephraim (v. 16)?
- 10. What was Hosea's response to Israel's present condition before the LORD (v. 17)?
- 11. What is an imprecatory prayer?
- 12. Should Christians pray imprecatory prayers today? Why or why not?
- 13. If Christians may pray imprecatory prayers, what would be the conditions and circumstances under which they should do so?
- 14. What does liberalism mean when it is applied to Christianity?
- 15. How "liberal" may one be and still legitimately retain the name "Christian"?
- 16. What does "orthodox" mean? What is an orthodox church? What is the Orthodox Church?
- 17. How should a Bible-believing, orthodox creed-confessing church go about calling a liberal church or a liberal Christian back to the true faith of the Scriptures?
- 18. Does a spiritual failure ever profit a believer in Christ?

- 19. Who are some people in the Bible who failed spiritually? What happened? How did they respond to their failures?
