Hosea 2:14-23

- 1. What kind of wife did God command Hosea to marry (1:2)?
- 2. After punishing Israel for her sins, what would the LORD do for Israel (2:19-20)?
- 3. When Hosea's wife had been separated from him for a time, what did God command him to do (3:1-2)?
- 4. What were some major sins that Israel committed against the LORD (4:1-2)?
- 5. Where did Israel turn for help when she was in trouble (5:13)?
- 6. What does God desire more than sacrifices and burnt offerings (6:6)?

7. What was a typical attitude that Israel had that contributed to her downfall (7:10; see also Proverbs 16:18)?

- 8. What serious responsibility did Israel violate (8:1)?
- 9. What country would invade and destroy Israel (11:5)?

10. What would the LORD God do for Israel after disciplining and punishing her for her sins (14:4)?

11. Why do think God may have ordered Hosea to enter a bad marriage? What other prophets did God direct to do certain strange or weird actions?

12. What does the term "redemptive-historical" mean?

13. How could people that had been warned so many times and in so many ways about the serious sin of idolatry end up engaging in such a vile and wicked practice even to the point of offering human sacrifice (13:2)?

14. Why is the word "judgment" and messages about judgment off-putting to many people? In this day and age, how should preachers apply messages in Scripture that center on judgment?

15. If the LORD judged and destroyed Northern Israel, how can one say that He did not give up on Israel?

16. If jealousy is bad, how can God act [Hosea 11:1-7] and say [Nahum 1:2] that He is a "jealous" God?

17. Where do you see Christ pictured or foreshadowed in Hosea?

18. How does the work of Christ fulfill the message of Hosea?

19. What prominent truth stands out to you from the book of Hosea?

20. What additional themes do you think should have been discussed from Hosea that you do not think were adequately addressed?
