

June 1, 2025 – Questions to Discuss and Consider at Home or in Small Group
“God Reinforces Moses and Aaron as His Leaders” -- Exodus 6:13-7:7

Questions for Younger Ones (ages 5-12) to Answer from the Text:

1. What was God’s charge to Moses and Aaron (6:13)?
2. Who were the two oldest sons of Jacob (6:14-15)?
3. Who was the patriarchal head of Moses and Aaron’s family? How old was he when he died (6:16)?
4. What were the names of Moses and Aaron’s parents (6:20)?
5. What was the name of Aaron’s wife (6:23)?
6. What kind of a role would God establish for Moses before Pharaoh (7:1a)?
7. What kind of role would Aaron have with Moses when he would speak to Pharaoh (7:1b)?
8. What would the LORD God do to Pharaoh that would make him not listen to Moses (7:3-4a)?
9. What would cause Pharaoh to allow God’s people to leave the land of Egypt (7:4b)?
10. How old were Moses and Aaron when they went to speak to Pharaoh?

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

11. Was it right and proper for Moses and Aaron’s father, Amram, to marry his aunt? Why or why not?
12. Why does Moses insert his and Aaron’s genealogy into the story at this point?
13. Why does Moses list only three sons of Jacob in the genealogy?
14. How do we know that the list of names in the genealogy given does not include all the descendants in the families listed?
15. What is noteworthy about Aaron’s grandson Phinehas?
16. In what sense can we say that Moses was brought back from the “dead”?
17. Which is more significant, the family or the individual? Why?
18. How does a Christian family stay spiritually strong and vibrant?
19. What are the main views about God’s hardening Pharaoh’s heart?
20. How does the LORD reaffirm His call to be His child in your life?
21. What has gotten harder about your Christian life? What has become easier?
22. How do you know that you will stand firm when things in your life become hard?
