## August 31, 2025 – Questions to Discuss and Consider at Home or in Small Group "The New Ways of God in the New Land" -- Exodus 13:1-16

## Questions for Younger Ones (ages 5-18) to Answer from the Text:

- 1. Who was to be consecrated to the LORD (v. 2)?
- 2. In what month did Israel leave the land of Egypt (v. 4)?
- 3. What nations were currently inhabiting the land that God was giving to the Israelites (v. 5a)?
- 4. What kind of land was the place God was bringing His people (v. 5b)? What does the expression "land of milk and honey" mean?
- 5. How many days were the people required to eat unleavened bread once they were in the land (vv. 6-7)?
- 6. What was to be observed at the end of the feast after eating unleavened bread the previous days (v. 6)?
- 7. What was to remind the Israelites of God's Law during this special time (v. 9)?
- 8. How often was Israel to observe this feast of Unleavened Bread (v. 10)?
- 9. In addition to the firstborn male sons, what else was to be dedicated as holy to the LORD (v. 12)?
- 10. What was an Israelite to do with a firstborn donkey? If he refused or failed to do this, what must he do (v. 13a)?
- 11. What were Israelite parents required to do regarding their firstborn son (v. 13b)?
- 12. When an Israelite firstborn inquired about the meaning of being redeemed, what were his parents to tell him (vv. 14-16)?

## Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

- 13. Why do you suppose that God designated only the males of the family to be the firstborn even though a female may have been born chronologically first in line? Does this have any significance for us today?
- 14. What are some ways you find helpful to assist you to remember God's Word throughout the day?
- 15. In what sense have you come to a "new land"?
- 16. What are some "old ways" that need to be replaced in your life?
- 17. How is your life "new" in Christ? How is your life not "new" after coming to Christ?
- 18. Are you consecrated to God? Are you holy? If so, how?
- 19. How was Passover a covenant renewal?

- 20. Is every day sacred for the Christian? If so, how can one day be more special than another?
- 21. Why is the gathering of God's people on the Lord's Day a "sacred assembly"?
- 22. What does redemption mean?
- 23. How do the concepts of "firstborn" and "redemption" relate to Christ Jesus?
- 24. Why must a person be redeemed? From what is the Christian redeemed? How is the Christian redeemed? When is the Christian redeemed?
