August 10, 2025 – Questions to Discuss and Consider at Home or in Small Group "God Gives Specific Directions for His Passover" -- Exodus 12:1-28

Questions for Younger Ones (ages 5-12) to Answer from the Text:

- 1. What significance would the time of the Passover have for Israelite life (v. 2)?
- 2. What animal was to be used for the Passover ritual (vv. 3-5)?
- 3. What were the Israelites to do with the animal used in the Passover ritual (vv. 6-10)?
- 4. How were the Israelites to eat the Passover meal (v. 11)?
- 5. Why would the LORD strike down the firstborn of Egypt but spare the firstborn of the Israelites (vv. 12-13)?
- 6. What were the Israelites to do in the future at this time of year once they were in the land God would give to them (vv. 14-20)?
- 7. Who were to help in making sure that the Israelites carried out God's instructions about the Passover ritual (v. 21)?
- 8. Who would enter the houses of the Egyptians on that night but not be allowed to enter the houses of the Israelites (v. 23)?
- 9. How long were the Israelites to observe the Passover (v. 24)?
- 10. Who were expected to ask questions about the meaning of Passover (v. 26)?
- 11. Who were required to answer the questions of those who asked about the meaning of the Passover (v. 27a)?
- 12. How did the Israelites receive and respond to what Moses and Aaron told them to do (vv. 27b-28)?

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

- 13. Why was Passover to be memorialized in Israel?
- 14. Is there a sense in which Passover continues to be observed today in the Church?
- 15. How do we know that the Lord's Supper is the fulfillment of Passover (see Matthew 26:17-29)?
- 16. In what ways is Passover relevant for the Christian today?
- 17. In what ways is Passover not necessary for the Christian today?
- 18. Why did God require Israel to carry out this ritual to protect itself? Why didn't God just come against Egypt as He did in the other plagues?
- 19. Does gathering with God's people, hearing His Word, and partaking of the Lord's Supper enable you to start your week in a positive way? If so, how? If not, why?

- 20. How much sinless perfection do you need to achieve before you partake of the Lord's Supper?
- 21. What preparations do you find beneficial to uncover and remove any leaven of sin prior to partaking of the Lord's Supper?
- 22. Is it proper to observe the Lord's Supper privately or in a small group? Why or why not?
- 23. How would you explain what the Lord's Supper means to a five-year-old?
- 24. How does the Passover ritual of Exodus 12 inform you of what to do today to be right with God?
