Questions for Younger Ones (ages 5-18) to Answer from the Text:

- 1. What metaphor does Jesus use to show that He completely satisfies a person's needs (v. 35)?
- 2. Who are those who truly come to faith in Jesus (v. 37)?
- 3. What will Jesus do for those whom the Father gives to Him (v. 39)?
- 4. What is the Father's will for all who believe in Jesus (v. 40)?
- 5. How did the Jews respond to Jesus' metaphor about Himself (v. 41)?
- 6. How did Jesus answer the complaint of the Jews (vv. 43-44)?
- 7. Who genuinely come to believe in Jesus (v. 45)?
- 8. What does a person who believes in Jesus come to possess (v. 47)?
- 9. What happened to those who ate the manna from heaven that God gave in the wilderness (v. 49)?
- 10. What is the bread that will enable someone to live forever (v. 51a)?

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

- 11. Why are people unable of themselves to come to faith in Christ Jesus?
- 12. Why do some people believe in Christ Jesus and others do not? What makes the difference?
- 13. How can a person determine if he has been effectually called by God?
- 14. If God is completely in charge of salvation, does this mean there is nothing that we do in the process? Why or why not?
- 15. What misconceptions and misunderstandings might arise from an inaccurate understanding of Effectual Calling?
- 16 How can God be just in holding individuals accountable to believe in Him if they are unable to do so?
- 17. What are the ordinary means God uses to effectually call people to Christ Jesus?
- 18. Is it appropriate to tell individuals that belief in Jesus is contingent upon God's granting it first? Why or why not?
- 19. What is the proper way to understand the saying, "I have decided to follow Jesus"? What is the improper way to understand this phrase?
- 20. How does the truth of Effectual Calling enhance your walk with Christ Jesus?
