

February 15, 2026 – Questions to Discuss and Consider at Home or in Small Group

“Israel Receives Directions for Meeting with God” – Exodus 19:1-25 (Part 2)

Questions for Younger Ones (ages 5-18) to Answer from the Text:

1. What was God’s first instruction to the people to prepare themselves to meet Him (vv. 9b-10)?
2. In the second instruction God gave through Moses to the people, on what day did the people need to be ready to meet God (v. 11a)?
3. What would happen on the day the people met with their God (v. 11b)?
4. What was the third instruction the LORD gave the people through Moses (v. 12a)?
5. What warning did God give the people when they came to Mount Sinai (v. 12b)?
6. What would happen if the people ignored or disobeyed this warning (v. 12c)?
7. How was the punishment for the person who ignored or disobeyed this warning to be handled (v. 13a)?
8. Who else beside the people could not cross the boundaries set on the mountain (v. 13b).
9. What was the signal that indicated the people could approach the mountain (v. 13c)?
10. Who consecrated the people (vv. 14-15)?

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

11. What does it mean to be consecrated?
12. In the text, how was consecration procured? What might this indicate?
13. In what way(s) are we consecrated to God today?
14. What makes the church gathering unique and special?
15. How might you personally ensure that gathering for worship does not become commonplace or routine?
16. How do you prepare to meet with the LORD in the gathered assembly of saints?
17. Is worship dangerous? Why or why not?
18. What helps you concentrate and not be distracted when you gather for worship?
19. In this passage, in what ways is Moses a parallel to Christ?
20. What, if any, significance might the phrase “the third day” (vv. 11, 15-16) have? (see Gen. 1:10; Gen. 22:1-4; 40:20; 42:18; 2 Kings 20:5; Ezra 6:15; Est. 5:1; Hos. 6:2; Jonah 2:1-9; Matt. 16:21; 17:23, 63-64)
